## Shadows from Around the World Come to Killingworth

A family-oriented puppet show following the artistic development of the Shadow Theater is coming to the Arts Center at Killingworth. *Shadows from Around the World* will be performed twice on Saturday, June 5, at Old Town Hall—the first 95-minute show starts at 11 a.m., the second at 2 p.m.

District 35 State Representative Brian O'Connor helped in acquiring SBC as the show's corporate sponsor, which has provided funding to the nonprofit Arts Center.

"After discovering SBC Communications had community outreach programming funds available for our area, I brought to its attention the contributions of the Arts

Center to our community," said O'Connor. "I hope to continue to foster corporate sponsorship of the arts with generous partners such as SBC."

According to the Arts Center, *Shadows from Around the World* comprises stories from around the globe in a series of comedic short stories, vignettes, and songs. After each performance, there will be short presentation; between 12:30 and 1 p.m. a workshop is being held for children over the age of six.

University of Connecticut alumnus Jim Napolitano will perform *Shadows from Around the World*. A graduate of UConn's Puppetry Program, Napolitano has performed internationally, and his credits include shows for Nickelodeon,
